## READINGS

Daniel 12:1-3; Psalm 15(16):5,8-11; Hebrews 10:11-14,18

**PSALM RESPONSE:** Preserve me, God, I take refuge in you

Jesus said to his disciples: 'In those days, after the time of distress, the sun will be darkened, the moon will lose its brightness, the stars will come falling from heaven and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory; then too he will send the angels to gather his chosen from the four winds, from the ends of the world to the ends of heaven.
