Jeremiah 17:5-8; Ps 1:1-2. 3. 4, 6. R Psalm 40(39):5a; 1 Corinthians 15:12, 16-20 **PSALM RESPONSE:** Blessed the man who has placed his trust in the Lord.

At that time: Jesus came down with the Twelve and stood on a level place, with a great crowd of his disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem and the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon.
