They should consistently use this over the next months to be eligible to register for the First Holy Communion programme. It will not be possible to register otherwise.

## **NOVEMBER DEAD LIST AND CANDLE SPONSORSHIP FOR 40 HOURS DEVOTION**

Envelopes for Mass offerings for the November Dead are available now in the repository. All evening Masses in November are offered for the souls of the faithful departed whose names will be recorded in the Book of the Dead. It is also possible to sponsor a sanctuary candle for the 40 Hours Devotion (from 26 Nov) when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed across a number of days. Envelopes are also available in the repository.
